Euro Payments will not be processed

Friday 1st May is a European Bank Holiday and a non processing day for Euro electronic payments. As a result, Danske Bank customers will not be able to receive or send domestic or international Euro payments on this date.

Other currencies are unaffected.

Monday 4^{th} May 2020 is a local Bank Holiday in Ireland meaning there will be <u>no</u> Euro payments processed from Danske Bank accounts in Ireland on this date also.

As a result, Danske Bank customers cannot process Euro payments from Friday $1^{\rm st}$ May to Monday $4^{\rm th}$ May inclusive.

Euro Wages, Salaries and Supplier Payments to Irish Beneficiaries.

Where Danske Bank Government Banking customers require staff and/or suppliers to be paid prior to the May Bank Holiday weekend, payments and files should be submitted for processing no later than 10.30am GMT on Wednesday 29h April for accounts included in the PMG cash pool. For accounts excluded from the PMG Cash Pool, the cut-off time is 15.30 GMT on Wednesday 29th April. Payments sent after these times may not be credited to the beneficiary account until Tuesday 5th May.
