Bank Holidays - Ireland 2026

Below you will find a list of Irish Bank Holidays in 2026.

- Outgoing Payments Excluding SEPA instant payments which are processed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, Danske Bank will <u>not</u> process outgoing payments (all currencies) on Irish Bank Holidays.
- **Incoming Payments** Danske Bank will **not** process incoming payments on Irish Bank Holidays, with the exception of incoming SEPA payments.
 - o Incoming standard SEPA payments will be credited to customer accounts on Irish Bank holidays with value/interest date the following banking day.
 - Incoming instant SEPA payments will be credited to an account upon receipt

May 1st 2026

On Friday, May 1st 2026, outgoing Euro payments (excluding instant SEPA payments) will **not** be processed by Danske Bank. Additionally, Monday, May 4th is a bank holiday in Ireland. As a result, customers will be unable to process the following EUR payment types on either date:

- Same Day Domestic payments
- Account Transfer External payments
- EUR Transfers Abroad (Standard, Express, and Group).

Standard EUR domestic payments (Account Transfer External payments in District) due to be credited on Friday May 1st, will need be processed on Wednesday 29th April for credit to the beneficiary account on Thursday 30th April.

Thursday 30 th April	Tuesday 5 th May

The May 1st Euro payments holiday applies to Euro only, meaning other currencies are unaffected. Excluding SEPA instant payments, no payment transactions will take place on Monday 4th May.
