MT 900 - Confirmation of debit

Scope

Danske Bank uses this SWIFT message to notify the account owner of an entry which has been debited to its account. The entry will be further confirmed by statement.

Usage

This message type is used as a confirmation to the receiver (account owner) of a debit to its account originated by a MT101 message.

Prior to taking the functionality included in this message type into use, an agreement must be made for ordering the message by contacting Danske Bank.
